Based in Leeds & conceived in 2013, Northern Monk has cemented its reputation & become one of the North's fastest growing drinks companies. With a love of New England IPA's they have crystallised their vision of becoming the number one Hazy IPA brewer in the UK - led by Faith. A Little Faith is a Hazy Pale Ale packed with soft fruit flavours. It's smooth, tropical, citrus & juicy, at a sessionable 4%.

## OSSIAN, INVERALMOND BREWERY (British Ale) 4.1% Pint £5.90 / half £2.95

Their brewers select flavour packed, slow kilned ale malt, caramalt and biscuity malted wheat to craft a malt backbone which is then beautifully complemented by a heady hop aroma of zesty lemon and orange citrus. This golden ale finishes refreshing and moreish. Amongst many awards, cask OSSIAN has won CHAMPION BEER OF SCOTLAND and bottled OSSIAN has won SILVER for BEST BRITISH STYLE ALE at the 2019 SCOTTISH BEER AWARDS..

## STONE BREWING, NEVERENDING HAZE (Hazy IPA) 4% Pint £6.30 / half £3.15

A hazy, golden and fruity, session strength IPA from California's Stone Brewing Co. At an easygoing 4% ABV Stone Neverending Haze IPA is a really refreshing beer a lovely tart tanginess. Intense citrus flavours of orange and lime are followed by oats and tropical pineapple. Nicely weighty on the palate with a finish which is dry and slightly bitter it's a beer that implores you to take another sip.

## ASAHI SUPER DRY (Lager) 5.2% Pint £6.10 / half £3.05

Japans #1 beer, born in Tokyo in 1987 Asahi Super Dry redefined the beer category - inspired by the dry taste of sake, the master brewers created the worlds first super-dry beer; crisp  $\mathcal{E}$  clean with a quick finish, it prepares your palate for whatever comes next.

## TENNENTS LAGER 4% Pint £4.80 / half £2.40

Tennents Lager is brewed to meticulously high standards, using exceptional ingredients and characterised by its clean taste and refreshingly crisp finish.

## ORCHARD PIG REVELLER (Cider) 4.5% Pint £5.20 / half £2.60

Bursting with West Country bittersweet cider apples, expertly crafted to their own special blend, slowly matured for a great taste with real character....Reveller has a generous apple aroma, drawing you in to a crisp, refreshing cider with a tangy note of freshly squeezed lime in the finish.



## CORONA EXTRA (4.5%) £4.70

## MAISEL'S WEISSE (Wheat) 5.2%) £6.70

The bright reddish-amber hue of Maisel's Weisse comes from the careful selection of the finest wheat and barley malts, while its unique character stems from the Bayerische Edelreifung - a traditional method of brewing using our own pure culture yeast handed down from one generation of master brewers to the next. The fresh scent of fine yeast and pleasant fruity notes combine with the mild, spicy aroma of malt, fruit and clove with a touch of nutmeg in the first sip. Maisel's Weisse's characteristic slightly fruity, yet complex weissbier aroma comes to the fore in the finish. (500ml)

## SCHNEIDER WEISSE TAP 01 (Blonde Wheat) (5.2%) £6.70

TAP1 Helle Weisse is a sparkling treat for those who love blonde wheat beers. This beer's full aroma displays the power of sunripened wheat. The artisanal brewing method together with the open fermentation give this wheat beer specialty its unique flavor. Full-bodied and sparkling with refreshing citrus and hoppy notes. (500ml)

#### VERDANT BREWING CO.

Based in Penryn Cornwall. Verdant focus on making hazy, hop-forward beer  $\mathcal{E}$  delivering as fresh as possible. Founded in 2014 this microbrewery was voted RateBeer's best new brewery in 2017  $\mathcal{E}$  continues to go from strength to strength. The company continually struggle to meet the feverish demand for their beers.

### PEOPLE MONEY SPACE TIME (Pale Ale) (3.8%) £6.60

Our little showstopper with the superstar pairing of Citra and Mosaic. The label might say 3.8% but this drinks like a 5%er for sure. Crazy feels for this meagre strength. We dry hop it at levels that feel illegal. Fresh off the line this beer is a monster! (440ml)

Founded in 2011 & based in Leith, Matt & Patrick spotted a gap in the market for beer that wasn't a US clone or traditional ales. Their focus has always been on quality & drinkability with flavour at the front & centre, shunning fining & filtration ensuring every beer tastes supreme. The first brewery in Scotland to stop using isinglass finings to clarify their beer makes the range vegan friendly. With all the base malts exclusively grown in Scotland, helping make this brewery sustainable.

## IPA (5.2%) £6.30

The newest kid on the block  $\mathcal{E}$  their flagship IPA, this is a beer that is perfect for every occasion. Extra pale  $\mathcal{E}$  dryhopped at 3 stages,  $\mathcal{E}$  awash with notes of pineapple, pink grapefruit  $\mathcal{E}$  resinous pine, it's a seriously juicy number. (330ml)

## PEACH MELBA SOUR (4.3%) £6.20

Quickly becoming an Edinburgh icon, our Peach Melba Sour is a lip-smacking sour beer inspired by the popular pudding of yore. Full of peach, raspberry & vanilla. (330ml)

## MOCHACCINO STOUT (5.5%) £6.40

Big-bodied and full-flavoured with an infusion of coffee (roasted and ground to our exact specifications), cocoa nibs and vanilla – our Mochaccino Stout is rich, comforting and darkly delicious. (330ml)

Lucky Saint is born of Bavarian spring water, pilsner malt, hallertau hops and their single-use yeast for a unique lager that is unfiltered & uncompromising. (330ml)

## ASAHI (0.0%) £5.60

A Born in Tokyo in 1987, Asahi Super Dry redefined the beer category and introduced the world to a new "super dry" taste in beer. Now their Master Brewers have combined pioneering Japanese brewing techniques with the finest ingredients to brew a beer that has the same crisp and refreshing Asahi Super Dry taste, without the alcohol. (330ml)

## SCHNEIDER WEISSE ALKOHOLFREI (Wheat) (0.5%) £5.50

You can tell it's going to taste great for a non-alcohol beer by its colour alone: 'Schneider Weisse non-alcohol' - the slightly darker, isotonic thirst-quencher energises with 100% wheat beer taste at less than 0.5% alcohol. This is how a 'free' beer should taste: strong - just like Bavaria. (500ml)

Burnside Brewery's first in Alcohol-Free in their range is called Right to Roam and is an IPA at 0.5% ABV. This is brewed in small batches using a special yeast strain to be naturally alcohol free using finest Scottish malts and mountain water. (330ml)

### BEAVERTOWN LAZER CRUSH (IPA) (0.3%) £5.30

Heavyweight flavour, featherweight ABV. An in-your-face IPA, that just happens to be alcohol-free. Rather than brewing with small amounts of malt or dealcoholizing after fermentation- for Lazer Crush a clever strain of yeast that fully ferments crisp pilsner malt is used, without producing alcohol & adding a hint of peachy fruit to boot. (Italy) £7.00 125ml / £34 bottle

A light straw yellow with fine bubbles. A pleasant bouquet with notes of pear  $\mathcal{E}$  white flowers that follow onto a palate which is bright  $\mathcal{E}$  clean with a refreshing finish (11.5%).

## CA DI ALTE, PROSECCO ROSE (Italy) £8 125ml / £36 bottle

A beautiful peach pink, with a fine and persistent perlage. On the nose, intense fruity aromas of peach, raspberry & ripe passion fruit. On the palate, it is full-bodied with a pleasant acidity and a fresh and harmonious flavour (11.5%).

## CHARLES HEIDSIECK, BRUT RÉSERVE (France) £90 bottle / £60 1/2 bottle

The nose is characterised by complex pastry aromas, with an opulent combination of ripe apricot, mango, greengages, dried fruits, pistachio and almond. The palate begins with a silky-smooth sensation, developing into ripe fleshy apricot, melon and enticing plum pastry notes and delicate spice. There is perfect balance of freshness and generosity.

## GABRIËLSKLOOF, `ROSEBUD` BOT RIVER

(South Africa) £8.30 175ml / £23 500ml (carafe) / £34 bottle

Beautifully elegant and aromatic wine that has pronounced aromas of watermelon, papaya, white peach and grape-fruit. The palate is juicy and dry, balanced perfectly by a refreshing acidity (12.5%).

## CHÂTEAU BEAULIEU, `CUVÉE ALEXANDRE' PROVENCE ROSÉ

(France) £11 175ml / £28 500ml (carafe) / £42 bottle

Brilliantly clear and salmon pink in colour. On the nose, delicate aromas of white flowers, redcurrant, and wild strawberry develop into juicy white peach and pear notes. On the palate, a fresh acidity is balanced beautifully by the alcohol and nuances of papaya, giving an elegant mouthfeel and refreshing length (12.5%).

## SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH, RIBBONWOOD

(N-Zealand) £9 175ml / £24 500ml (carafe) / £35 bottle

An engaging nose, with aromas of grapefruit peel, a hint of thyme and gentle stony minerality. On the palate, there are flavours of lemon with sweet herbal and redcurrant flavours. Supple and satisfying, the wine is balanced by a fine acid backbone (13%).

## CHARDONNAY, CACHAPOAL VALLEY, SANAMA RESERVA

(Chile) £8 175ml / £22 500ml (carafe) / £32 bottle

Light yellow with youthful green highlights. On the nose, tropical aromas of peach and pineapple combine with hints of honey. A subtle sweetness on the palate is balanced by a generous natural acidity (13%).

## PINOT GRIGIO, CA DI ALTE (Italy) £7.60 175ml / £21 500ml (carafe) / £30 bottle

Straw yellow in colour, this wine has delicate citrus perfumes, an attractive biscuit character & white floral notes on the nose. Medium-bodied, with good balance, it has great finesse & a fresh, rounded finish(13%).

## DUFFOUR PÈRE ET FILS, IGP CÔTES DE GASCOGNE

(France) £7.80 175ml / £21 500ml (carafe) / £31 bottle

An excellent value white, a blend of Colombard, Gros Manseng and Ugni Blanc is clean and modern in style without any oak influence. Having undergone a period of lees ageing, it displays more weight and aromatics than many other wines from this area (11.5%).

## SHAW + SMITH 'M3' CHARDONNAY, ADELAIDE HILLS

(Australia) 2021 £14 175ml / £56 bottle

A contemporary and elegant Chardonnay from one of the Adelaide Hills' most exciting producers. White flowers, citrus, and nectarines on the nose, alongside smoky notes from perfectly integrated oak.

The 'M3' opens with aromas of white flowers, grapefruit, and white peach. Notes of brioche and toast add complexity to the elegant fruit. The palate is long and flavoursome, with great texture and bright acidity. Savoury, toasty nuances from the oak are beautifully integrated and linger on the finish(13.5%). (Silver International Wine Challenge 2021) (Decanter 96)

## BODEGA GARZON ALBARINO RESERVA (Uruguay) 2022 £10 175ml / £40 bottle

This Albariño is of a pale yellow colour with greenish reflections and fruity aromas reminding of peach; balanced with citric notes. It is fresh and mineral with a marked acidity and a long and rounded aftertaste in mouth. Its ripening time takes place between 3 to 6 months on fine lees in stainless-steel tanks (13.5%).

## DOMAINE DE L'ENCLOS CHABLIS (France) 2022 £14 175ml / £56 bottle

This Chablis from the dynamic Bouchard brothers is bright with lifted fruit  $\mathcal{E}$  waxy with a touch of lemon zest which gives way to a zesty creaminess on the palate. Unoaked  $\mathcal{E}$  beautifully expressive, it shows why Domaine de L'Enclos is one of the most exciting new domaines in Chablis. This Chablis boasts bright, lifted citrus fruit on the nose. The palate is beautifully balanced, with elegant  $\mathcal{E}$  steely acidity, alongside concentrated flavours  $\mathcal{E}$  a textured mouthfeel (13%).





## THORNE & DAUGHTERS, 'CAT'S CRADLE' SWARTLAND CHENIN BLANC (South Africa) 2021 £13 175ml / £52 bottle

Cat's Cradle' is sourced from a single parcel of old bush-vine Chenin Blanc in Paardeberg, & displays a very pure and vibrant expression of Chenin Blanc. On the nose are aromas of lemon balm, apple blossom, and honey. The palate is richly textured, and lifted by bright acidity and a wet stone freshness with a long, elegant finish (13%). (Decanter 95)

## CRYSTALLUM CLAY SHALES CHARDONNAY, WALKER BAY (South Africa) 2022 £68 bottle

The 2020 is an emphatic expression of a now famous site. Lemon meringue, apple blossom and lime leaf are bolstered by arresting tropical notes of lychee and pineapple on the nose. A rindy, flinty mouthfeel adds a pithy and moreish texture on the palate while peach and buttered popcorn combine towards a remarkably long finish (14%). (Decanter 94)

## FRAMINGHAM F-SERIES SAUVIGNON BLANC, MARLBOROUGH (New Zealand) 2021 £48 bottle

This wine represents an atypical style of Sauvignon Blanc for Marlborough, being very textural with tastes of earth and mineral rather than fruit. A strictly limited edition, the F-Series allows head winemaker Andrew Hedley and his team to experiment with winemaking techniques and create small batch wines that capture the essence of each vintage, resulting in some of Marlborough's most exciting wines. A fine, expressive Sauvignon Blanc with grapefruit aromas and underlying notes of ginger and toast. The palate is creamy and textural, full of stone fruit and savoury complexity (13.5%). (Decanter 91)

## GREYWACKE WILD SAUVIGNON, MARLBOROUGH (New Zealand) 2020 £54 bottle

Made by one of Marlborough's most respected winemakers – Kevin Judd – this is a superior Sauvignon Blanc, a wonderfully intense combination of nectarines, peaches, elderflower with a citrus twist & a delicate herbal infusion.

An aromatic salsa-like fusion of ripe summer fruit and fragrant Asian spices. Nectarines and yellow peaches, rock melon, grapefruit  $\mathcal{E}$  a splash of passionfruit, mingled with ginger and lemongrass, jasmine flowers and cassis. A deliciously ripe and zesty Marlborough Sauvignon with a lemony, citrus thread that finishes crisp  $\mathcal{E}$  dry (13.5%). (Decanter 96)

## FRAMINGHAM CLASSIC RIESLING, MARLBOROUGH, (New Zealand) 2021 £37 bottle

Made from some of the oldest Riesling vines in New Zealand, this is a fantastic wine, complex  $\mathcal E$  characterful. Typical stone  $\mathcal E$  petrol notes combine on the nose with the palate offering a rich  $\mathcal E$  sumptuous texture  $\mathcal E$  depth of flavour. This is juicy  $\mathcal E$  mouth-watering but also full-bodied, with powerful flavours of sweet pineapple, peach, orange zest, mango  $\mathcal E$  melon (12.5%). (Decanter 92)

## BY FARR, COTE VINEYARD 'GC' CHARDONNAY, GEELONG (Australia) 2020 £130 bottle

Made from small quantities of single vineyard Chardonnay, hand-harvested and fermented using whole bunches adding texture and enhancing aromas. The trademark characteristics of the wine are understated power and length with a mineral finish. The wine has a great fruit expression that is well integrated with French oak. The soil characteristics have come through in the style of wine. The palate is fine but firm, with great acidity, texture and length. This wine is rich in flavour, yet very refined (13.5%). (Decanter 97)





## AMALAYA CALCHAQUI TORRONTÉS/RIESLING (Argentina) 2021 £30 bottle

This wine is pale gold in colour with youthful highlights. On the nose, there are intense aromas of grapefruit and lemon peel, which is typical of Torrontés, balanced by a touch of minerality and floral notes. On the palate, it has a crisp acidity with a long, mineral finish - great with spicy food (13%). (Decanter Sliver)

## MOUNT HORROCKS, 'WATERVALE, CLARE VALLEY SEMILLON (Australia) 2018 £45 bottle

Made from organically-grown grapes in Watervale in the Clare Valley, this 100% barrel fermented Semillon is well balanced, intense  $\mathcal E$  long. Citrus peel  $\mathcal E$  green apple, baked pear a $\mathcal E$  hazelnut praline, with a creamy texture, finishing dry. This wine is pale gold in colour. Vibrantly fruited for a barrel-aged white, displaying textured  $\mathcal E$  layered lemon fruit  $\mathcal E$  spicy oak, with a touch of creamy lees complexity. Great acid balance  $\mathcal E$  impressive length of flavour (12.5%). (Decanter 93)

## TOLPUDDLE VINEYARD, COAL RIVER VALLEY CHARDONNAY, TASMANIA (Australia) 2019 £105 bottle

On the nose, this wine is intensely aromatic with lemon peel, white blossom, wet stone  $\mathcal{E}$  a captivating struck match note. Notes of mandarin, white peach  $\mathcal{E}$  biscuit are complemented by mouth watering fresh acidity. There is intensity but also plenty of texture  $\mathcal{E}$  verve, as well as a long finish. A strikingly beautiful chardonnay with its flowery bouquet bearing witness to the sheer purity of the incredibly long palate, the full palette of chardonnay flavours on display. Nectarine, white peach  $\mathcal{E}$  grapefruit zest are sewn together by an invisible silver thread of acidity (13%). ## GROSSET, 'POLISH HILL' CLARE VALLEY RIESLING (Australia) 2021 £86 bottle

This is the benchmark for all Australian Riesling. Geoffrey Grosset is an unbelievably talented winemaker  $\mathcal{E}$  his skills with the Riesling grape are undeniable. He has raised the status of Aussie Riesling to one that competes comfortably on the world stage. This most recent release of this iconic wine is a taut, steely, bone dry wine of incredible intensity. One of the very best you'll ever try. A spectacular vintage with layer upon layer of powerful lime juice aromatics against a backdrop of enticing florals. The palate is intense with lime pith flavours, weight, power  $\mathcal{E}$  a crisp, ultra-dry finish that lingers. It has the structure and intensity of flavour to become one of the great vintages. ## TINPOT HUT, MARLBOROUGH PINOT GRIS

#### (New Zealand) 2022 £40 bottle

Pale straw yellow in colour, this wine boasts fragrant aromas of spice, pear and stone fruit, with underlying notes of brioche and freshly cut spring flowers. The well-rounded palate balances fresh pear, stone fruit and nutmeg with a vibrant acidity for a mouthwatering  $\mathcal{E}$  lingering finish.

## TABLAS CREEK, ESPRIT BLANC DE TABLAS, PASO ROBLES, ADELAIDA, CALIFORNIA, (USA) 2019 £98 bottle

White Rhône blend of Roussanne, Grenache Blanc, Picpoul Blanc and Picardan from Tablas Creek's Regenerative Organic Certified vineyards in Paso Robles. Delicate floral nose, leading into a rich, mineral mouthful of complex citrus and honeysuckle, with hints of pineapple. Lovely pure, creamy texture, with bright acidity and a lifted, airy quality. (13%) (Decanter 94)

## KAIKEN CLÁSICO, MENDOZA MALBEC

(Argentina) £8.50 175ml / £24 500ml (carafe) / £34 bottle

Deep purple in colour. On the nose there are aromas of red fruits such as plums and blackberries, complemented by notes of chocolate and tobacco. On the palate this wine displays extraordinary balance, freshness and soft tannins (14%).

### THREE LIONS, GREAT SOUTHERN PINOT NOIR

(Australia) £11 175ml / £28 500ml (carafe) / £42 bottle

Three Lions Pinot Noir is deep ruby red in colour. On the nose, there are lifted aromas of red cherry, raspberries & a savoury complexity that leads into a palate bursting with bramble fruits & toasty oak. This Pinot Noir is beautifully textured with fine tannins & balanced acidity (14%).

## EXCELSIOR, ROBERTSON MERLOT, BREEDE RIVER VALLEY

(S-Africa) £8.20 175ml / £23 / £33 bottle

On the nose, aromas of rich blackberry and plum mingle with coffee and smoke. The palate displays a juicy core of berry fruit, underpinned by soft, well-integrated tannins and notes of sweet spice (14.5%). (Silver Medal Decanter World Wine Awards 2021)

## 16 STOPS, SHIRAZ, (Australia) £8 175ml / £22 / £32 bottle

This deep crimson-coloured Shiraz is youthful and vibrant, with a lovely dark fruit and spiced plum character on the nose. The oak supports the fruit, which is bright and lively on the palate while offering earthy notes of nutmeg and black pepper. The tannins are ripe and velvety, giving the wine texture (14.5%).

## GIANT STEPS, `APPLEJACK VINEYARD` YARRA VALLEY PINOT NOIR (Australia) 2021 £17 175ml / £68 bottle

This highly acclaimed Pinot Noir from the Yarra is very herbaceous on the nose with smoky, cherry fruit and pronounced green bell pepper. The youthful palate has a refined feel with tight tannins  $\mathcal{E}$  great length (14%). (Gold - DWWA 2020) (Decanter 93)

### SPICE ROUTE 'CHAKALAKA' SWARTLAND

(South Africa) 2019 £11.50 175ml / £46 bottle

Named after the signature spice blend of South Africa, this huge wine is made from classic Rhône varieties (36% Mourvèdre, 22% Syrah, 13% Carignan, 11% Grenache, 9% Petite Sirah, 9% Tannat). This wine is deep ruby red in colour. On the nose, aromas of clove  $\mathcal E$  subtle white pepper are followed by plum, blackberry  $\mathcal E$  cherry. This wine has a full-bodied  $\mathcal E$  rich palate with well-integrated oak and smooth tannins (14%).

### 'EL COTO, 'COTO DE IMAZ', RIOJA GRAN RESERVA

(Spain) 2016 £12 175ml / £48 bottle

The Gran Reserva has a brilliant ruby-red colour with tinges of brick red. Mature  $\mathcal{E}$  elegant, the wine's rich aromatic complexity is initially subtle, revealing itself more and more as the wine opens. Toasted oak nuances  $\mathcal{E}$  coconut give way to notes of leather  $\mathcal{E}$  damp earth from bottle ageing. On the palate, silky, rounded tannins accompany fresh red berries, dried raisins  $\mathcal{E}$  spicy notes. This is a complex wine with exceptional concentration  $\mathcal{E}$  a long finish (13.5%). (Best in show - DWWA 2019)





## WILLUNGA 100, `THE TITHING` MCLAREN VALE GRENACHE (Australia) 2016 £12.50 175ml / £50 bottle

Willunga's flagship, a single vineyard wine made only in the best years from small parcels of the finest old bush vine Grenache, is matured in old French oak Hogsheads to add complexity and richness to the intense fruit character. The Tithing is a dark, deep, rich style of Grenache  $\mathcal{E}$  shows how diverse this grape can be. The flavours of lifted dark fruit with powerful savoury overtones reflect the winemaking approach, which allows time in oak and bottle before release. Ripe, persistent tannins give the wonderfully balanced fruit great length  $\mathcal{E}$  intensity (14.5%). (Gold Sommelier Wine Awards 2019)

## SEGHEISO, SONOMA COUNTY ZINFANDEL, California (USA) 2020 £14 175ml / £56 bottle

This wine is made from the finest grapes grown in the region, with an emphasis on balance and complexity. Classic California this Zinfandel is full-bodied, fruit-forward with intense flavours of blackberry, black cherry, and spice, which are complemented by the subtle tannins  $\mathcal{E}$  lively acidity. The wine has a long finish with a hint of vanilla and oak. (15%)

## DOMAINE TOLLOT-BEAUT, CHOREY-LÈS-BEAUNE, BURGUNDY (France) 2020 £80 bottle

In the glass, the wine is a bright ruby red. The nose is expressive, with aromas of red cherries  $\mathcal{E}$  floral notes. The palate is lean with racy acidity  $\mathcal{E}$  fine, velvety tannins.

## BY FARR, GEELONG SHIRAZ (Australia) 2019 £110 bottle

A powerful nose, with the depth and complexity of cool-climate shiraz. This wine is spiced with pepper and mineral elements, leaning towards earthy. The co-fermented Viognier adds a little richness to both the bouquet and palate, which has a very pleasant sweetness to start, followed by intense fruit and earthy long tannins to complete the delicate structure and overall elegance of the wine. (13.5%). (Decanter 93)

## DAWSON JAMES, TASMANIA PINOT NOIR (Australia) 2017 £112 bottle

The Pinot Noir has great delicacy  $\mathcal{E}$  balance. Aromas of ripe cherries  $\mathcal{E}$  rose petals are complemented by the savoury oak influence. Complex  $\mathcal{E}$  layered, with smooth tannins, it has a creamy texture  $\mathcal{E}$  a wonderfully long finish (12.6%). (Trophy - International Wine Challenge 2021)

## BODEGA GARZON ESTATE, RESERVE TANNANT (Uruguay) 2020 £36 bottle

Deep purple in colour, with aromas of plums  $\mathcal{E}$  raspberries and just a hint of spice. On the palate, this is a full-bodied wine, with mature tannins complementing the dark juicy fruit  $\mathcal{E}$  mineral notes. Striking  $\mathcal{E}$  powerful (14.5%). (Decanter 93)

## HEIRLOOM VINEYARDS, BAROSSA SHIRAZ (Australia) 2018/2019 £38 bottle

This wine is intense purple in colour with youthful highlights. There is a remarkable concentration of spicy black fruits on the nose with a subtle background of balsamic & allspice. The palate is soft and structured with velvety tannins. The finish is long and lingering with dark chocolate notes.

(Winemaker Challenge International Wine Challenge (USA) 2020- Platinum Medal, 94 Points, San Diego International Wine & Spirits Challenge 2020 – Platinum Medal, 94 Points, Barossa Wine Show 2020 – Gold Medal, 95 Points)





## BALNAVES, COONAWARRA CABERNET/MERLOT (Australia) 2014/2017 £44 bottle

Cabernet Sauvignon blended with a small component of Merlot, this is deep red in colour, with a plush nose, round blackberry, elderberry  $\mathcal E$  cassis fruits and toasty oak. The palate has a soft dark plum, cassis fruit character  $\mathcal E$  fine grain tannins; matured for 16 months in French oak (50% new). Excellent crimson-purple; the bouquet is aromatic  $\mathcal E$  inviting, the palate with a balance of blackcurrant, mulberry, black olive  $\mathcal E$  herbs, oak adding its own flavour as a bonus (14.5%).

## 'WILD SLOPES' APALTA SLOPES, OUTER LIMIT BY MONTES, CGM (Chile) 2019/2021 £48 bottle

(Carignan 50%, Grenache 30%, Mourvèdre 20%). From Montes' single vineyard 'La Finca Apalta', arguably one of the best sites for grape growing in Chile, this CGM blend demonstrates balance and freshness. Ruby red in colour, the nose offers clear notes of ripe red fruit  $\mathcal{E}$  wild blackberries, accompanied by subtle vanilla, nutmeg,  $\mathcal{E}$  sweet cinnamon touches from the oak ageing. The palate is refreshing, with good acidity  $\mathcal{E}$  fruit expression  $\mathcal{E}$  smooth, juicy tannins. Black  $\mathcal{E}$  red fruit emerge here, with an elegant  $\mathcal{E}$  persistent finish (14.5%). (Decanter 91)

## GIANT STEPS YARRA VALLEY, LIGHT DRY RED (Australia) 2021 £50 bottle

An exciting new addition to the Yarra Valley range from 2017. A sensual blend of juicy red Pinot perfume is seasoned with the darker, peppery Syrah component. Sweet fruit, nuttiness  $\mathcal{E}$  smoky clove spice characters, with a hint of reduction adding savoury complexity. Everything comes together in this fruity, juicy, light-bodied style with a subtle grip  $\mathcal{E}$  elegant structure (13.5%).

## HENSCHKE, 'KEYNETON EUPHONISUM' BAROSSA (Australia) 2018 £82 bottle

Shiraz Bordeaux blend with 66% Shiraz, 19% Cabernet Sauvignon, 10% Merlot & 5% Cabernet Franc - Deep crimson with garnet hues, this wine is enticing on the nose, with aromas of blackcurrant, blackberry and cassis, enveloped by herbal notes of sage and bay leaf that lead to subtle nuances of red fruits, black pepper, vanilla & cedar. The generous palate offers rich flavours of red & blackcurrant, dried herbs & black pepper, with great purity, balance & texture forming a delicious mouthfeel, while velvety tannins provide great length & complexity (14.5%).(SILVER - DWWA 2021 / SILVER - IWC 2021)(Decanter 93)

## GROSSET, `GAIA` CLARE VALLEY CABERNET SAUVIGNON/CABERNET Franc (Australia) 2014/2018 £105 bottle

Planted at 570 metres, at the highest point of the Clare Valley, the Gaia vineyard is a rocky, isolated, wind-swept two hectare block close planted by Grosset in 1986. From Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc. The 25th release of Grosset Gaia has restrained, brooding almost briary, aromatics with violet notes; fine structure with a firm backbone  $\mathcal{E}$  pleasing supple blackcurrant and bramble flavours; well-integrated, gently gripping tannins that are long  $\mathcal{E}$  ultra-dry (13.7%). (Decanter 94)

## MITOLO, 'SERPICO', MCLAREN VALE, CABERNET SAUVIGNON (Australia) 2018 £88 bottle

Made solely from Cabernet Sauvignon, it is made from lightly dried grapes in an 'Amarone' style. This drying gives a richer, fuller style,  $\mathcal{E}$  a superb wine of great individuality. On the nose, there are intense aromas of rich blackberry  $\mathcal{E}$  ripe plum complemented by notes of dark chocolate, vanilla  $\mathcal{E}$  figs. It is a full-bodied wine with mouth-coating, fine grained tannins leading to a long, savoury finish (15.5%).





## HENSCHKE, 'JOHANN'S GARDEN' GRENACHE/MATARO/SHIRAZ, Barossa (Australia) 2017 £78 bottle

Crimson with garnet hues. Bright, lifted aromas of redcurrant, rosehip and raspberry develop into concentrated baked plum pudding with spicy notes. The soft, luscious palate is complemented by complex flavours of spiced berry compote, raspberry and red liquorice. An elegant style with fine, velvety tannins and balanced acidity. (SLIVER DWWA 2021)(Decanter 91)

## KOOMILYA, 'JC BLOCK' MCLAREN VALE SHIRAZ (Australia) 2015 £110 bottle

A single block Shiraz from 80-year-old vines. The fruit which spent 14 days on skins with the hard pressings removed, was then transferred to stainless steel until early May. The wine was then moved to puncheons for malolactic fermentation and maturation  $\mathcal{E}$  spending a total of 14 months in oak. This wine is an assault of many aromas and flavours that sweep together in one fluid motion, bound in the Koomilya signature of split red wood  $\mathcal{E}$  mahogany. Silky tannins play across the back palate, soft yet powerful, enveloping and supple with deep spice  $\mathcal{E}$  cassis flavours that surprise and delight. This wine is deep red in colour. Aromas of blackcurrant, cherry  $\mathcal{E}$  raspberry are complemented by spicy notes from the oak. On the palate, it is soft, yet powerful, with silky tannins. A complex wine with great length  $\mathcal{E}$  concentration on the finish at marks this out as a special wine. Outstanding. An Australian classic (14%). (96+ points. Gary Walsh, The Wine Front October 2021)

## LEEU PASSANT, OLD VINES `BASSON` WELLINGTON CINSAULT (South Africa) 2018 £98 bottle

This vineyard always shows plenty of structure, power and focus and the 2018 vintage is considered one of the most structured yet. In its current youthful state, the aromatics are distinctively stony and mineral but also fabulously perfumed showing notes of potpourri, lavender, bramble berries, fynbos and Turkish delight. The palate is incredibly precise and foursquare with a polished structure and frame you just don't expect from such a delicately fragrant wine. The texture is dense and tightly packed, the wine concentrated and intense but also deceptively light on its feet revealing notes of cranberry, red cherry and wild strawberries on the finish all supported by the most powdery, silky tannins imaginable. A difficult wine to put accurately into words because it is so evocative on both an emotional level as well as on a sensorial level. Drink this wine from release and over the next 30+ years (13%). (Decanter 96)

## Weet AND Sweet

## CHAMBERS ROSEWOOD, RUTHERGLEN MUSCAT

(Australia) £7.50 (75ml) / £37 bottle (375ml)

The Rutherglen Muscat is tawny in colour with aromas of rose petals  $\mathcal{E}$  dried fruit. These characters carry through to the palate, balanced with fresh acidity. The wine is unctuous  $\mathcal{E}$  rich yet zesty  $\mathcal{E}$  balanced - this is a superb wine to sip on its own, with cheese or with a wide variety of desserts. It is a reminder that Rutherglen produce some of the greatest sweet wines in the world. (18%).

## CULLEN, MARGARET RIVER, LATE HARVEST CHENIN BLANC (Australia) £8.50 (75ml) / £40 bottle (375ml)

This wine is light gold in colour. On the nose are aromas of stewed apples, cooked mandarins, beurre noisette and sultanas. The palate opens up to flavours of apple pie, maple syrup, honey and caramel notes. This is a full-bodied, textured wine with great persistence of flavour and dashing acidity. (9.5%)
